## **POOL ADMISSION:**

Online recreation pool passes are required for admission to the pool and to participate in all instructional programs.

**Seasonal Pool Passes** are available to all Holden Residents only and can be purchased **online** at [www.holdenrec.com](http://www.holdenrec.com).

**Daily Pool Passes** are available for Holden Residents with proper ID. Non-residents may accompany a Holden resident for the day for an additional fee. Daily passes are available to purchase with cash at the Pass checker office and are good for the day.

**Residents with seasonal pool passes and daily pool passes must provide a photo ID and proof of residency when checking in at the pool.**

## **REGISTRATION AND POOL PASS SALES:**

**Online registration** for Holden residents will begin Monday, March 7 at 9:00 a.m.

**Online registration** Non-residents programs only will begin Monday, April 18 at 9:00 a.m.

## **WHAT'S NEW AT THE POOL:**

In attempt to make the pool admission smoother, all physical pool passes **will not be** given this summer. In order to check in at the pool you must buy seasonal pass online or daily pass at the pool. When checking into the pool residents must show Pass Checker a valid ID upon each entry to the pool area. The Pass Checker will verify your pool pass membership with the Holdenrec.com system upon entry at the pool. Daily passes must be purchased using cash.

## **POOL HOURS:**

The pool will open the first weekend in June. Hours until school is out for the summer pool will include Saturday and Sunday 12-4:45. Once school has finished for the year the pool hours of operation will change.

**Holden Resident Season Pass:** \$50.00 each. Proof of residency required.

**Holden Family Season Pass:** \$160.00 for a family of 5. Each additional immediate family member is \$20. **This DOES NOT include grandparents, aunts, uncles, nieces, nephews, etc.**

Children younger than 1 do not need a pass, unless they participate in a class.

**Holden Resident Nanny Pass:** \$50.00 each. A resident can purchase 1 pass for their babysitter. That pass will be assigned to that 1 babysitter.

**Holden Senior Season Pass:** \$18.00 each (age 65 or older).

**Daily Pass (CASH ONLY):** Holden resident, Legal ID needed, - \$8.00 per person

**Daily Resident Guest Pass (CASH ONLY):** Must accompany Holden Resident - \$15.00 per person

# **LIFEGUARDING CERTIFICATION AND RECERTIFICATION**

**(Does not require seasonal pool pass to register)**

## **American Red Cross Lifeguard Certification**

This course is designed to prepare lifeguard candidates to prevent, recognize, and respond to aquatic emergencies, breathing and cardiac emergencies, and standard first aid injuries.

The course is a Blended Learning format, which means students must complete a portion of the class online, prior to the start of the class. Once a student is registered they will receive a link to a Red Cross website to complete approximately 8 hours of computer work.

### Lifeguard candidates:

- Must be 16 years of age by the last session of the class
- Successfully pass pre-test:
  - Swim 300-yards continuously using the front crawl and breaststroke
  - Tread water for 2-minutes without using arms
  - Retrieve a 10-lb weight from 7-feet of water and then swim 20-yards using legs only in less than 1 minute, 40 seconds
- Complete eLearning requirements
- Pass a written test (at least an 80%) and a skills evaluation

Upon successful completion of the lifeguard course, candidates will receive an American Red Cross Lifeguard Training certification, a First Aid certification and a CPR/AED for the Professional Rescuer certification all valid for 2 years.

Participation is mandatory all 5 days. Classes are held rain or shine. You will be participating in strenuous activities and may want to discuss any medical issues with your physician.

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## **American Red Cross Lifeguard RECERTIFICATION Review Class**

The course is designed to refresh the skills of currently certified American Red Cross Lifeguards including CPR/AED and First Aid.

### Lifeguard Recertification Participants:

- Must hold a current American Red Cross Lifeguard certification
- Successfully pass pre-test
  - Swim 300-yards continuously using the front crawl and breaststroke
  - Tread water for 2-minutes without using arms
  - Retrieve a 10-lb weight from 7-feet of water and then swim 20-yards using legs only in less than 1 minute, 40 seconds
- Pass a written test (80%) and a skills evaluation

Upon successful completion of the Recertification course, candidates will receive an American Red Cross Lifeguard Training certification, a First Aid certification and a CPR/AED for the Professional Rescuer certification all valid for 2 years.

Trout Brook Recreation Area is 660 acres Holden conservation land with a system of trails for walking, cross-country skiing and mountain biking. Entrances on Manning Street, Mason Road and Sterling Road have parking. A gathering area around the pond includes a picnic pavilion with tables, an open field and a lodge which may be rented for public or private use. Facilities in the lodge include 2 bathrooms, a fireplace, refrigerator, electric griddle, steamer, microwave (NO electric/gas stove/oven), 6 cafeteria tables and one serving table.

Lodge rental fee: \$200.00 / day or overnight for Holden residents, \$300.00 / day or overnight for non-residents or organizations not located in Holden.

Reservations to rent the lodge must be made by contacting the Holden Recreation Department at 508-829-0263.

## **RECREATION DEPARTMENT POOL POLICIES:**

**Pool philosophy:** Please protect our community, and your children. Parents are responsible for watching your children at all times.

- The Recreation Director and lifeguards have the authority to confiscate any Recreation seasonal or day pass that is misused. The Director, lifeguards and staff have the authority to ask patrons to leave the premises if rules are not followed. It is up to the discretion of the Director, if and when, the pass is returned.
- Participation in all Recreation Department programs is at the registrant's own risk.
- NO CHILD aged 12 or younger should be dropped off at the pool. All children should be under the supervision of an adult. It is the responsibility of that adult to watch the child/children in and/or out of the water. Lifeguards do not provide childcare services.
- Patrons should communicate any concerns to the Recreation Director or Head Guard.
- In inclement weather, the pool will open at the discretion of the Recreation Director. When thunder and lightning are evident, no one will be allowed in the water until 30 minutes *after* the last clap of thunder.

## **POOL RULES:**

- No running on the pool deck.
- Use the diving board or stairs to enter the lap pool; use ladders to exit.
- No ball playing on the pool grounds.
- An adult **MUST** be within an arm's reach of their non-swimmer child in the pool.
- Only U. S. Coast Guard approved personal flotation devices are allowed. A parent/guardian must be within an arm's reach of your child if he/she wears one.
- All children not potty trained, must wear clean, approved swim diapers.
- No conversing with lifeguards while they are on stand.
- No toys are allowed in the pools.
- You must be able to swim 1 length of the lap pool to use this pool.
- No glass bottles are allowed anywhere within the pool grounds.
- Inserting stakes into the ground for umbrellas, tents, etc. is not permitted.
- Parents are responsible for watching their children.

## **SLIDE RULES:**

- No one on the stairs while someone is going down the slide. You can proceed up the stairs once the person in front of you is completely off the slide you.
- No catching kids coming off the slide.
- One person on the slide at a time.
- No child who needs assistance is allowed on the slide.
- Must go down the slide feet first sitting up.
- No one is allowed to walk under the slide

## **RECREATION PROGRAM POLICIES**

### **REGISTRATION:**

**Online registration** for Holden residents will begin Monday, March 7 at 9:00 a.m.

**Online registration** Non-residents **programs only** will begin Monday, April 18 at 9:00 a.m.

### **REGISTRATION AND PROGRAM POLICY:**

All programs are offered on a first-come, first-serve basis. The Recreation Director reserves the right to cancel or consolidate classes. All Programs (excludes All Day) may be canceled due to the weather at the discretion of the Recreation Dept. Make-ups will only be offered if more than 2 days have been cancelled within the session (**No make-ups will be offered for 1 or 2 canceled days within a session**). Director will announce when make-ups are held. Refunds will not be offered due to a participant's inability to partake in the scheduled make-up. Refunds, credits or pro-rating will not be issued due to a participants inability to attend during regular session dates or make-up dates.

- Staff will not escort children from one class to another, unless the child is enrolled in either the Half Day or All Day Programs.

### **CHANGE/TRANSFER POLICY:**

For **any** changes made to the original program registration (time, swim level, session, etc.,) an \$8.00 fee will be applied for each change. (Excludes All Day and Lifeguard courses. Please see their page for policy information)

### **REFUND POLICY:**

- Seasonal Pool Passes are non-refundable and non-transferable.
- **No refunds or household account credits will be issued if withdrawal is requested less than 10 business days prior to the program start date. (Excludes All Day and Lifeguarding Courses. Please see their page for policy information)**
- Refunds will only be given via **household account credit** or **check**. Any refunds issued by check will be processed within 2 to 4 weeks. Per ordinance by the Treasury Dept. we are no longer able to process refunds by credit card.
